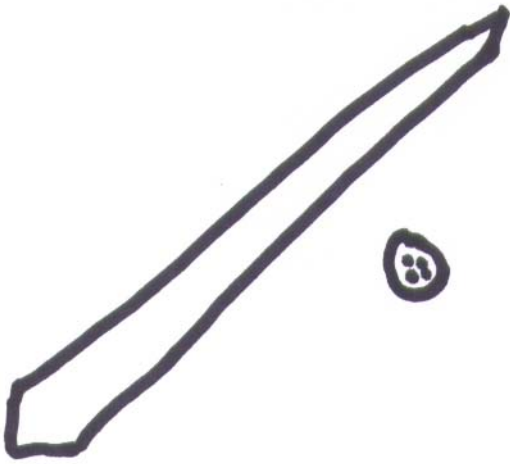


Necktie Headband

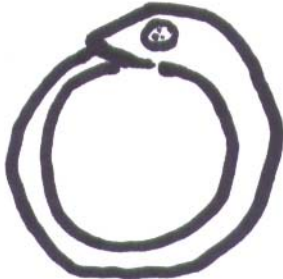
An old tie turns into a great new headband in just a few minutes!

You will need a men's necktie, 6" of elastic, needle and thread, a pair of scissors, an iron and a large button. If you have a sewing machine it will help, but isn't necessary.

Step 1. Pick a necktie you'd like to use and a large coordinating button.



Step 2. Overlap the large end of the necktie over the skinnier end, and using a needle and thread, sew a large button on top, sewing all layers together in place.



Step 3. Cut a section out of the opposite side of your new loop according to the size of your noggin. The remaining piece should reach behind one ear, across your head and behind your other ear with an additional inch for hemming.



Step 4. Turn the raw edges of the ends under 1/2" inch and press with an iron.





Step 5. Insert your piece of elastic inside each end of your tie and either machine or hand stitch securely in place! Viola, new headband for you!
